

1 John 1:9–10 (ESV)

<sup>9</sup> If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

# The remarkable promises in 1 John 1:9

What does God want us to do with our sins?

- What does it mean to confess?
- Is this easy?

Psalm 32:3 (ESV)

Blessed is the man against whom the Lord counts no iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit.

What does it mean to have no deceit?

What are two of God's attributes that are mentioned in 1 John 1:9?

Psalm 40:11-12 (ESV) (Read)

As for you, O Lord, you will not restrain your mercy from me; your steadfast love and your **faithfulness** will ever preserve me! For evils have encompassed me beyond number; my iniquities have <u>overtaken</u> me, and I cannot see; they are more than the hairs of my head; my heart fails me.

Why do we need God's faithfulness?

Because he will keep forgiving and stay faithful when we want to quit (As David says – "my heart fails me").

1 John 1:9 says, "God is faithful and just to forgive us..."

- What does it mean that God is "just" in forgiving us?
- What is the odd tension that this creates in us?

God's forgiveness is both a comfort and a strength.

What else does God want us to do when we confess our sins?

1 John 1:8 (Read)

What does John say that we should recognize about ourselves?

Ecclesiastes 7:20 (ESV)

Surely there is not a righteous man on earth who does good and never sins.

What should be our attitude toward sin?

Psalm 139:23-24 (ESV)

<sup>23</sup> Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts! <sup>24</sup> And see if there be any grievous way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting!

What should be our attitude toward sin?

Proverbs 28:13 (ESV)

<sup>13</sup> Whoever conceals his transgressions will not prosper, but he who confesses and forsakes them will obtain mercy.

Christ's completed work on the cross is our basis for forgiveness.

Hebrews 10:12 (ESV)


<sup>12</sup> But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God...
